The complete outfits consists of:

- 1 Jacket with attached hood. Interchangeable protective helmet in the hood. With 1 goldsteamed visor\*\* 15 x 25 cm
- 1 Pair of trousers with adjustable suspenders
- 1 Pair of 3-finger gloves, model H 20
- 1 Pair of rubber boots, acc. to S 10 DIN 4843, with heat reflecting gaiters
- 1 Spare visor
- 1 Carrying bag, with instructions for use, maintenance and packing, sewn-in under the flap.

This protective suit must be worn with a breathing apparatus under it.
